Scope and deliver data for analytic purposes (data designed for the construction of advanced mathematical models); measure, document, and address data quality issues;
Maintain datasets and dataset documentation; and contribute knowledge and expertise to the success of the project;
Act as liaison between business and IT, collaborate on technical issues that require IT involvement and business priority to fix. Communicate effectively;
Be concise and precise in written communication;
